

ORDINANCE No. 151058

An ordinance ratifying and making applicable to special elections
Section 2.04.030 of the Code of the City of Portland.

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. Section 2.04.030 of the City Code provides that an amendment to the Charter of the City may be proposed and submitted and an ordinance or measure may be referred to the legal voters of the City, by resolution of the Council without an initiative or referendum petition. Section 2.04.030 was enacted on January 21, 1981 by Ordinance No. 151003, an emergency ordinance.
2. That by reason of Section 3-104 of the charter of the City of Portland relating to filing dates for measures to be presented at special elections, it is necessary to ratify by non-emergency ordinances and make specifically applicable to special elections the provisions of Section 2.04.030 of the Code of the City of Portland.

NOW, THEREFORE, The Council directs:

- a. That Section 2.04.030 of the Code of the City of Portland is hereby ratified and made applicable in all respects to procedures relating to special City elections.
