

ORDINANCE No. 150903

An Ordinance authorizing the transfer of \$8,400 between object classes within the appropriation of the Bureau of Police to provide funds for professional services, and declaring an emergency.

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. That due to the expiration of the Federal Comprehensive Crime Prevention Grant on December 31, 1980 and the reorganization of the Crime Prevention Division, the Bureau of Police requires additional appropriations for professional services.
2. That these additional appropriations will provide for the development of a tracking and evaluation plan, to research alternative funding sources for the minority program and to prepare grant applications to potential funding agencies for the minority and sexual abuse programs for the Crime Prevention Division.
3. That the needed funds for the professional services are available from savings in Personal Services.
4. That \$8,400 should be transferred between object classes within the appropriation of the Bureau of Police, Crime Prevention Division.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. That appropriations be transferred between object classes within the appropriation of the Bureau of Police as follows:

Bureau of Police

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because the appropriations to be transferred are immediately required in order that the new functions may be carried out without delay; therefore, this Ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
