

ORDINANCE NO. **150906**

An Ordinance creating one position of Bicycle/Pedestrian Program Coordinator and abolishing one position of City Planner III in the Bureau of Street and Structural Engineering, establishing salary rates for the Compensation Plan, and declaring an emergency.

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. One position of Bicycle/Pedestrian Program Coordinator is required by the Bureau of Street and Structural Engineering.
2. This position is needed because the Civil Service Board has determined that the duties being performed by one position of City Planner III are more appropriately the duties of the Bicycle/Pedestrian Program Coordinator classification.
3. One position of City Planner III can be abolished to provide the necessary appropriation for the position being created.
4. The change has been approved by the Bureau of Personnel Services.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The following position is created in the Bureau of Street and Structural Engineering with salary rates as established in item c. below:
