

An Ordinance accepting a sewer easement right of way for the N.W. Belgrave Avenue, N.W. Essex Street, N.W. Vaughn Street and Private Property Sanitary Sewer Project, granted by Multnomah County, and declaring an emergency.

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. Right of way is required for construction of the N.W. Belgrave Avenue, N.W. Essex Street, N.W. Vaughn Street and Private Property Sanitary Sewer Project.
2. Multnomah County has conveyed the required right of way to the City at no cost to the City.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. That the following described easement is hereby accepted for sewer purposes:

That portion of Lot 40, Blythswood, Multnomah County, Oregon, lying southwesterly of the following described line:

Beginning at a point on the northwesterly line of Lot 40, Blythswood, being northeasterly 5.0 feet from the most westerly corner of said lot; thence S.61°53'40"E. 159.0 feet more or less to a point of the southeasterly line of said lot and being northeasterly 23.0 feet from the most southerly corner thereof and there terminating. (Granted by Multnomah County, c/o Harold Holub, 2505 S.E. 11th Avenue, Portland, Oregon 97202)

- b. The Auditor shall record in the appropriate deed records, documents of title as necessary for acquisition of this right of way.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because a delay in the acceptance of the sewer easement might result in delays in construction of the sewer; therefore, this Ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
