

ORDINANCE NO. 151079

An Ordinance granting a revocable permit to the Portland Water Bureau to place and maintain a prefabricated structure in the street area of N.E. 105th Avenue, and declaring an emergency.

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. The Portland Water Bureau has requested to place and maintain a prefabricated structure in the street area of N.E. 105th Avenue.
2. That this prefabricated structure is needed to protect water level measuring equipment.
3. The proposed structure under certain conditions would not be detrimental to the public interest.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:


- a. A revocable permit is granted to the Portland Water Bureau, permittee, to place and maintain a prefabricated structure in the street area adjacent to Lot 1, Block III, Parkrose Addition, and as located as shown on the plan marked "Exhibit A" attached to and by this reference made a part of this Ordinance, subject to the following conditions:
 - (1) This permit is for the use of the street area only, and shall not exempt the permittee from obtaining any license or permit required by the City Code or Ordinances for any act to be performed under this permit, nor shall this permit waive the provisions of any City Code, Ordinance, or the City Charter, except as herein stated.
 - (2) This permit is revocable at any time in the event the public's need requires it and no expenditure of money hereunder, lapse of time, or other act or thing shall operate as an estoppel against the City of Portland, or be held to give the permittee any vested or other right. Immediately upon the expiration of this permit, or upon its sooner revocation by the Council, the permittee shall remove said driveways from the street area as directed by and to the satisfaction of the City Engineer.


To place and maintain a prefabricated structure in the street area, adjacent to Lot 1, Block III, Parkrose Addition, 1/4 2441
