

ORDINANCE NO. 151086

An ordinance abolishing one position of Alarm Line Electrician I and creating one position of Electrician in the Bureau of Fire, and declaring an emergency.

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. That the Alarm line maintenance workload has been decreasing due to the continued removal of residential alarm boxes.
2. That the electrical systems maintenance workload has increased due both to the age of the Bureau's older structures and to increased number of fire stations.
3. That this position change will cause no increased expenditure for the Bureau since the salaries of the Electrician position and of the Alarm Line Electrician I position are identical.
4. That the needs of the Bureau of Fire can best be met through such action.
5. The Chief of the Bureau of Fire has recommended and the Bureau of Personnel Services has reviewed the position change.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The following position in the Bureau of Fire is abolished:

- b. The following position is created in the Bureau of Fire, with salary rate in accordance with the Current Compensation Plan:

The Council declares that an emergency exists in that the position being created is required immediately in order that the functions of the Fire Bureau Building Maintenance Section may be continued without delay; therefore, this Ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.


