ORDINANCE NO. **151089**

1.

An Ordinance authorizing the Purchasing Agent to call for bids to provide labor, equipment and materials for the conversion of existing twin ornamental street lights (multiple circuits) from mercury vapor to high-pressure sodium vapor for the Street Lighting Division, of the Department of Public Works, authorizing a contract, transferring \$500,000 from Capital Outlay to Materials and Services, within the Street Lighting Fund budget, authorizing the drawing and delivery of warrants, and declaring an emergency.

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. The Street Lighting Division requires labor, equipment and materials to convert existing twin ornamental street lights (multiple circuits) to high-pressure sodium vapor.
- 2. The Council approved funding of the project described above, in Fiscal Year 1980-81.
- 3. Within the Street Lighting Fund budget, it is necessary to increase the appropriation available in Materials and Services (240) by transferring funds from Capital Outlay (630).

NOW THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Purchasing Agent shall advertise for bids using specifications filed in his office on February 2, 1981 and in the event that no satisfactory bid is received, shall readvertise on the same basic specifications until a satisfactory bid is received.
- b. The Commissioner of the Department of Public Works and the Auditor hereby are authorized to execute a contract with the responsible bidder for the project described in Section 1 hereof, in accordance with specifications filed with the Purchasing Agent on Febraury 2, 1981.
- c. The following transfer of funds within the Street Lighting Fund Budget (332) is authorized:

BUC	33220022/630	(\$500,000)
BUC	33220022/240	\$500,000

d. The Mayor and Auditor hereby are authorized to draw and deliver warrants chargeable to the 1980-81; Street Lighting Fund, Street Lighting Division, 33220022/Project 6041/240, when demanded and approved by the proper authorities.
