

ORDINANCE NO. 150939

An Ordinance creating one position of Auditorium Operations Supervisor and one position of Auditorium Box Office Supervisor and abolishing one position of Stage Mechanic and one position of Clerical Specialist I in the Civic Auditorium effective January 1, 1981, establishing salary rates for the Compensation Plan, transferring \$1,100.00 within the Auditorium Fund, and declaring an emergency.

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. Two positions of Auditorium Operations Supervisor and Auditorium Box Office Supervisor are required by the Bureau of Civic Auditorium.
2. The increased level of activity has necessitated current employees to assume additional duties and responsibilities without compensation.
3. The two positions of Stage Mechanic and Clerk Specialist I can be abolished to provide partial appropriation for the positions being created.
4. The necessary additional appropriation should be provided by transfer within the Auditorium Fund.
5. The classification change and the new salary rates have been approved by the Bureaus of Civil Service and Personnel.

NOW, THEREFORE, The Council directs:

- a. The following positions are created in the Bureau of Civic Auditorium with salary rates as established in c. below:

- b. The following positions in the Bureau of Civic Auditorium are abolished:
