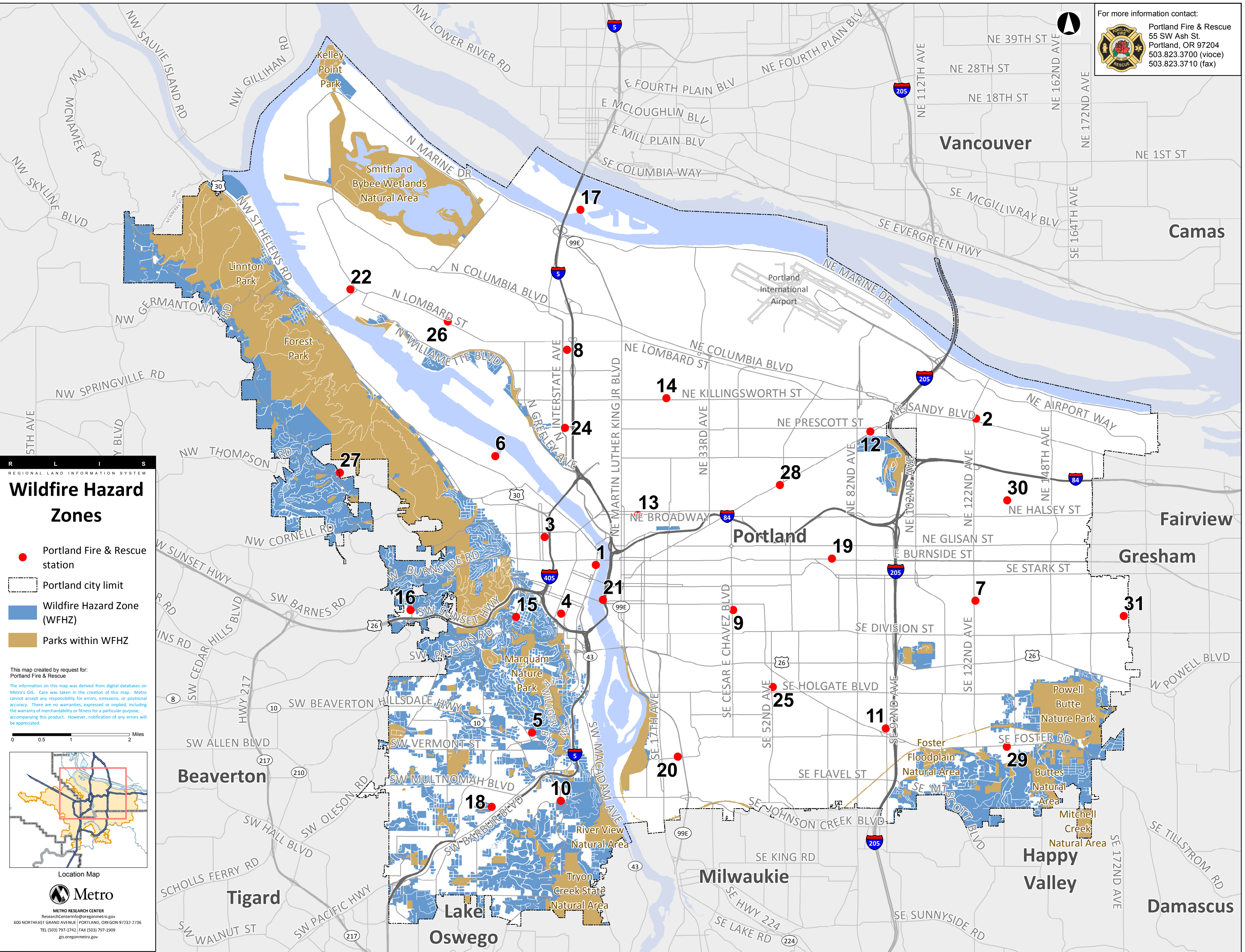



THIS HAS BEEN A CHRONIC PROBLEM AT THIS CAMP AND THE OCCUPANTS HAVE BEEN RESISTANT AND AGGRESSIVE TOWARDS FIRE COMPANIES TRYING TO ENFORCE THE BURNING RULES. 
**Wildfire Hazard Zones**

-  Parks within WFHZ

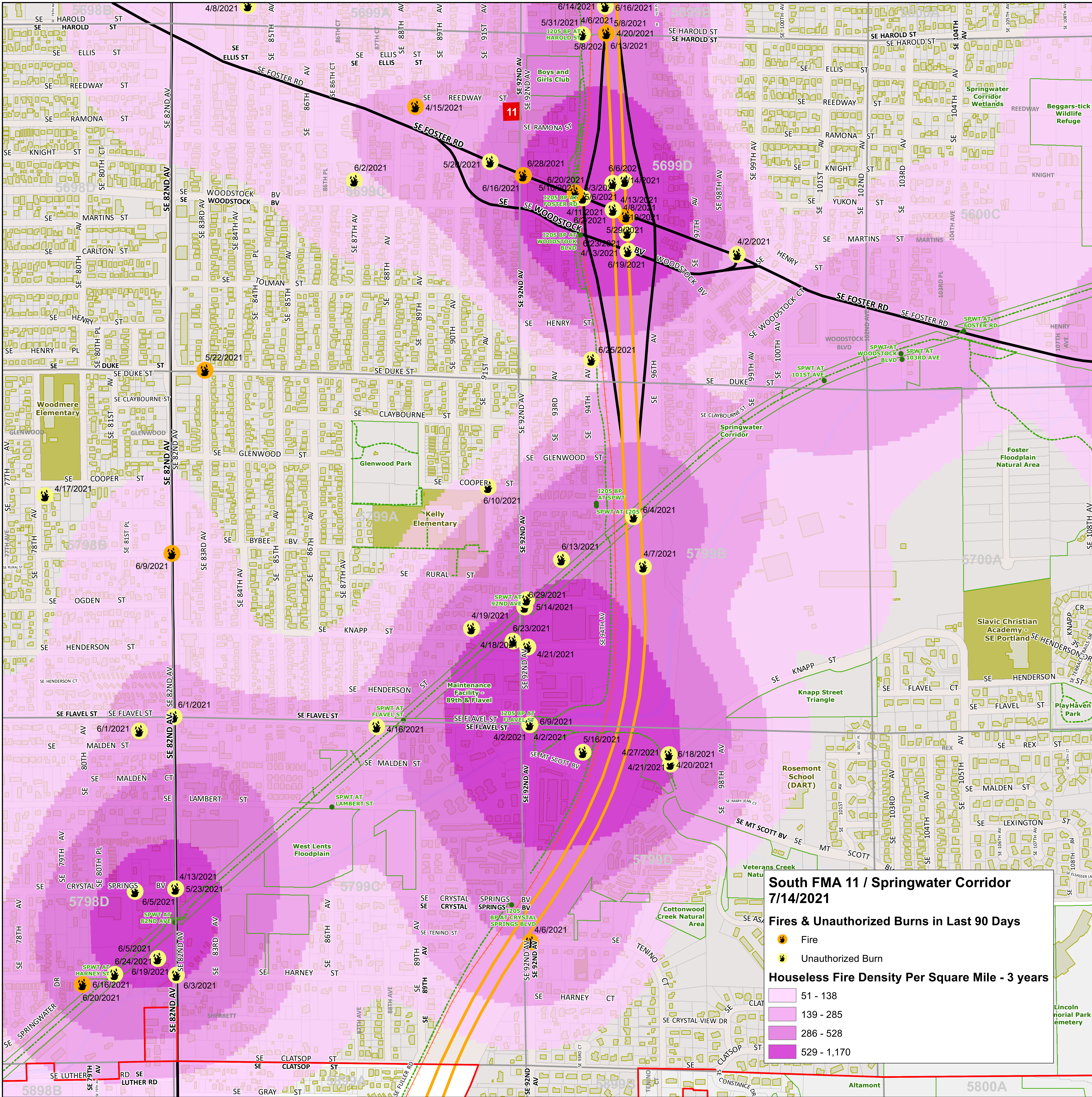

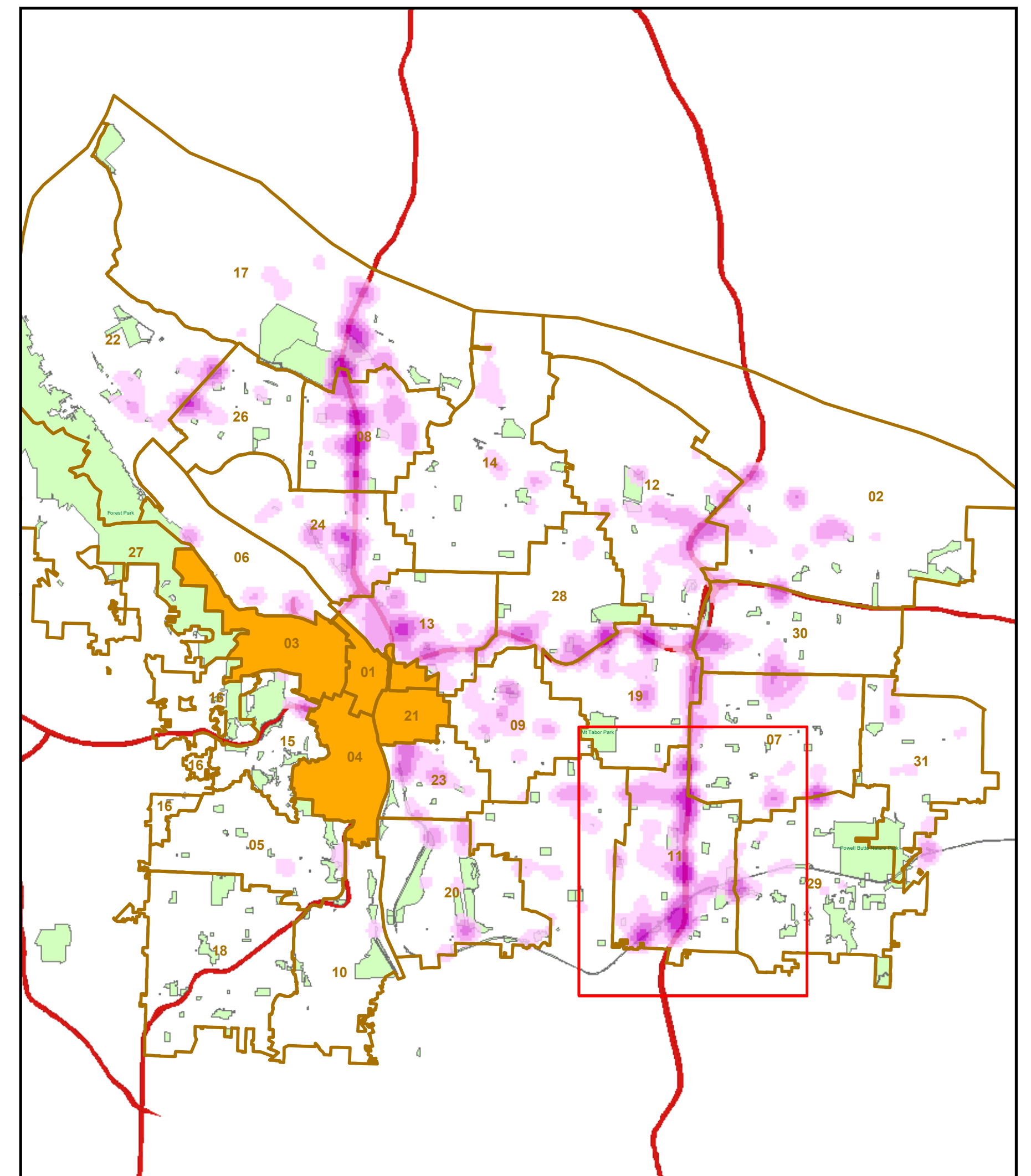

**Houseless Fire Density Per Square Mile - 3 years**

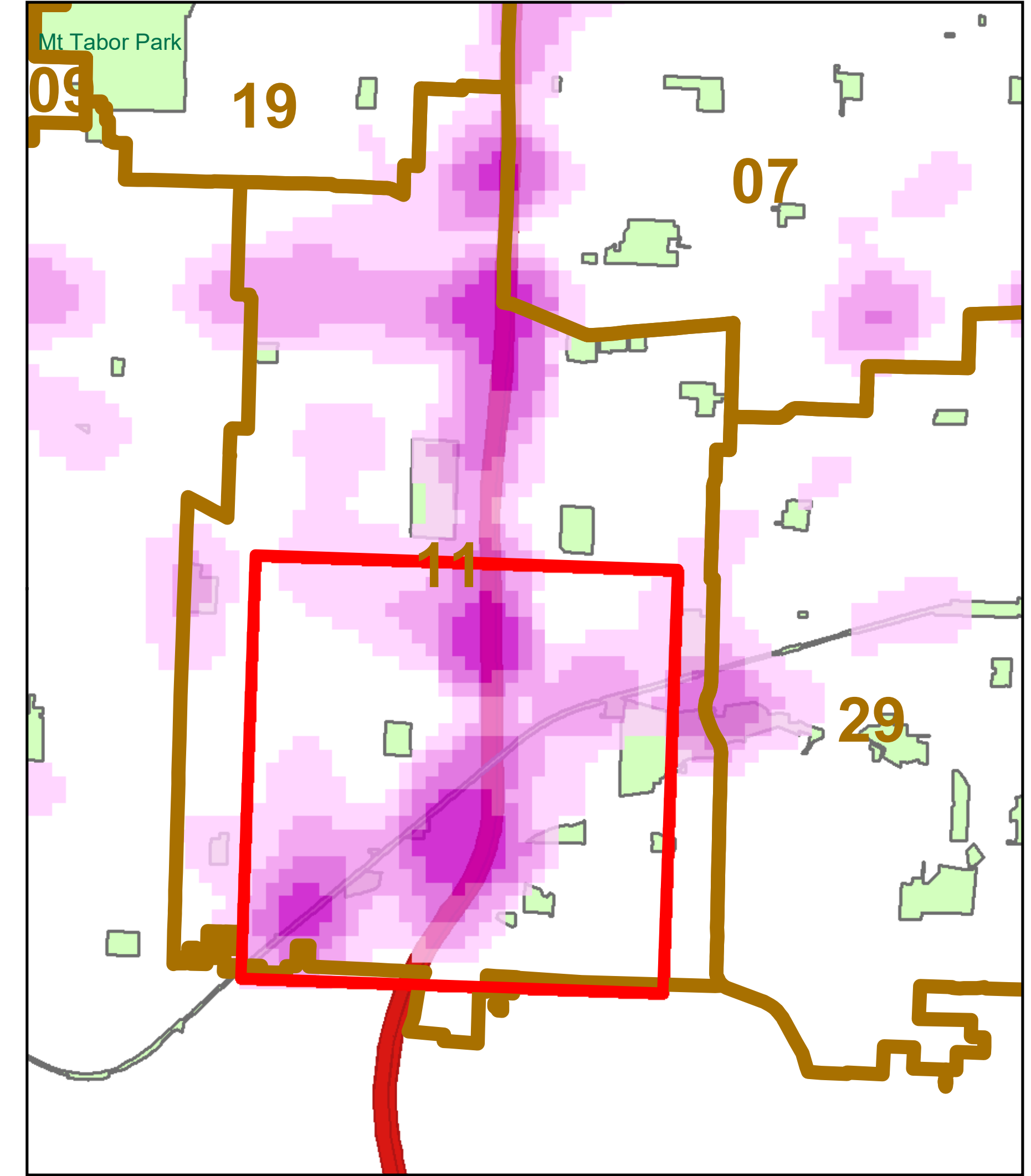

### Purpose of proposed legislation and background information:

A report to Council on the newly developed protocols by the Fire Marshall to balance the needs of the City's houseless population and managing the increasing risks of fires within the City.

### Financial and budgetary impacts:

Commissioner Hardesty's office and the Fire Marshall have met with several community organizations to discuss these policies and their rollout. While this will impact some houseless community members it is our hope that through clarity and outreach efforts that we will get broad voluntary compliance among houseless community members camping in dangerous areas.
