## Testimony to Portland City Council on the Design Overlay Zone Amendments, Recommended Draft

As someone who lives within three blocks of two of the corridors affected by DOZA, I am writing in support of DOZA and of the affordability amendments recommended by Portland: Neighbors Welcome.
