## Testimony to **Portland City Council** on the **Design Overlay Zone Amendments**, **Recommended Draft**

I am writing in support of DOZA and of the affordability amendments recommended by Portland: Neighbors Welcome. I consider myself fortunate to live in a mixed use part of my neighborhood, with access to frequent transit, bike facilities, and businesses. I want more people to be able to live in the same kind of dense, walkable, transit-accessible communities like those in the "d" overlay zone, regardless of income level.
