

## ORDINANCE NO. 151343

An Ordinance authorizing an increase of the \$11,437 Oregon Department of Transportation Portland Historic Resource Inventory project grant from the State Historic Preservation Office by \$3,000; authorizing the drawing and delivery of warrants; increasing resources and requirements in the General Fund by \$3,000; and declaring an emergency.

The City of Portland ordains:

## Section 1. The Council finds:

1. The Council expressed its support of the Portland Historic Resource Inventory project by approving the \$59,155 Bureau of Planning project budget for FY 80-81.
2. Ordinance No. 150417 authorized the acceptance of the \$11,437 Oregon Department of Transportation Portland Historic Resource Inventory project grant.
3. The State Historic Preservation Office has made available an additional \$3,000 for the project.
4. The FY 80-81 Bureau of Planning budget includes sufficient appropriations to provide the required 50 percent match.
5. A project agreement between the Bureau of Planning and the State Historic Preservation Office is required subsequent to passage of this Ordinance.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Commissioner-in-Charge and the Auditor are authorized to accept an increase in the amount of \$3,000 to the \$11,437 grant from the Oregon Department of Transportation and to provide other grant information and assurances as may be required to complete the grant agreement.
- b. The Commissioner-in-Charge and the Auditor are hereby authorized to draw and deliver warrants chargeable to the FY80-81 budget, General Fund, Bureau of Planning, AU 510, BUC No. 51249003/4210.

Section 2. The FY 80-81 budget is hereby amended by the increase in resources and requirements in the General Fund and transfer of appropriations as follows:
