

ORDINANCE NO. 151347

An Ordinance amending Ordinance No. 150054 to increase authorized expenditures in a sum not to exceed \$30,000, providing for a transfer of funds, and declaring an emergency.

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. Ordinance No. 150054 authorized an agreement with the law firm of Wickwire, Peterson & Gavin to assist the Office of the City Attorney in defense of an action filed in the U.S. District Court for the District of Oregon by Dorfman Construction Company, Inc., Civil Action File No. 80-539, and the expenditure of funds thereunder was limited to \$20,000.
- 2. The City Attorney advises that an additional expenditure in an amount not to exceed \$30,000 is necessary to continue with pre-trial matters that are presently being conducted.
- 3. The sum of \$15,000 is available from funds in the City Engineer's budget and it is appropriate that the City Engineer share in the costs as the Wickwire firm is involved in an engineering analysis in conjunction with its legal services and the City Engineer has agreed to provide said sum.
- 4. A transfer of funds in the amount of \$15,000 from General Operating Contingencies to the Office of City Attorney is necessary to provide the \$30,000 increase in authorized expenditures.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. Ordinance No. 150054 is hereby amended to authorize an increase of \$30,000 in expenditures for the services to be provided thereunder.
- b. In order to provide the necessary funds for the additional expenditures authorized hereinabove, funds will be transferred as follows:

\$15,000 from Sewage Disposal Fund, Bureau of Sanitary Engineering (BUC 14722009:210) to Other Funds, General;

\$15,000 from General Fund Contingencies to Office of City Attorney (BUC 31200067:210);

\$15,000 from General Fund Unforeseen Reimbursable Expenditures to Office of City Attorney (BUC 31200067:210).

All other terms and conditions of Ordinance No. 150054 remain the same.


ORDINANCE No.
