

ORDINANCE No. 151363

An ordinance authorizing the Purchasing Agent to call for bids to furnish pieces of equipment for the Bureau of Fleet Management, authorizing contracts, authorizing the drawing and delivery of warrants and declaring an emergency.

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. The Bureau of Fleet Management requires the purchase of a track mounted hydraulic backhoe for the Water Bureau at an estimate cost of \$80,000; and a crawler backhoe with a forty foot boom for the Water Bureau at an estimated cost of \$180,000.
2. These items are included in the current approved budget as replacement items, but were not included in the annual ordinance No. 150597.


NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Purchasing Agent shall advertise for bids using individual specifications filed in his office for the items found above, and in the event that no satisfactory bids are received, shall readvertise on the same basic specifications until satisfactory bids are received.
- b. Contracts are authorized with the most favorable bidders as designated by the Council.
- c. The Mayor and the Auditor hereby are authorized to draw and deliver warrants chargeable to the 1980-81 Budget, Fleet Operating Fund, Bureau of Fleet Management, BUC 56200037, Object 643 Equipment, Motor Vehicles, when demand is presented and approved by the proper authorities.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because a delay in proceeding with the purchase may result in additional expenses, and will unnecessarily deprive the City of the benefits of completion of the contracts at an early date; therefore, this Ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
