ORDINANCE No. 151368

An Ordinance authorizing the Bureau of Parks to install five traffic control gates within Mt. Tabor Park and declaring an emergency.

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. Disruptive activities within certain areas of Mt. Tabor Park require the installation of traffic control gates in five locations to permit regulation of vehicular traffic.
- 2. The necessary additional appropriation should be provided by transfer within the bureau budget.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Bureau of Parks is authorized to install five traffic control gates within Mt. Tabor Park.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because the authorization is needed to permit control of disruptive activities; therefore, this Ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
