ORDINANCE No. 151371

An Ordinance amending appropriations in the amount of \$254,137.00 in the Fleet Operating Fund and Bureau of Fleet Management, appropriating ending balance heretofore not budgeted, and declaring an emergency.

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. The certified FY 1979-80 audit of the City of Portland's financial records shows the Fleet Fund's balance available for appropriation to be \$701,399.00. However, the amount budgeted in the FY 80-81 is \$578,872.00, leaving a balance of \$122,527.00 for appropriation.
- 2. In addition, prior year encumbrances of \$131,610.00 have been cancelled, thus making that amount of money available for appropriation. Those figures have been documented by the Office of Fiscal Administration.
- Most of these funds are being appropriated for capital purchases planned for last fiscal year but being made this fiscal year while a small amount will be used for materials purchases.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

a. The FY 80-81 Budget of the Fleet Operating Fund is amended as follows:

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because capital replacements carried over from last fiscal year must be made this year and the funds are required; therefore, this ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
