ORDINANCE NO. 151372

An Ordinance authorizing the transfer of \$9,780 between object classes within the appropriation of the Bureau of Police for the purchase of movie equipment and operating supplies, authorizing the transfer of \$9,180 within the General Fund from the Bureau of Police to Transfers to Other Funds-Electronic Services and increasing the appropriation of the Electronic Services Fund, Bureau of Electronic Services, by \$9,180 for the purchase of video equipment, and declaring an emergency.

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. That the Bureau of Police recently reorganized its Juvenile Division to provide for a Community Juvenile Officer (C.J.O.) program.
- 2. That the C.J.O. program requires certain movie and video equipment and operating supplies as law enforcement teaching media in support of the Portland Public Schools.
- 3. That the funds needed for the purchase of said equipment and supplies are available from savings in Personal Services for the Juvenile Division.
- 4. That \$9,780 should be transferred between object classes within the appropriation of the Bureau of Police and that \$9,180 should be transferred to the Bureau of Electronic Services for the purchase of the said equipment and supplies.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

a. That appropriations be transferred between object classes within the appropriation of the Bureau of Police as follows:
