

ORDINANCE No. 151377

151377

An Ordinance authorizing use of Rose City Golf Course for the Rose City Best Ball golf tournament, April 25 and 26, 1981, for men, and May 7 and 8, 1981, for women, at special greens fees, notwithstanding provisions of Section 20.20.010 of the City Code, and declaring an emergency.

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. The Superintendent of Parks has recommended use of Rose City Golf Course for the City-sponsored City Best Ball golf tournament, April 25 and 26, 1981, for men, and May 7 and 8, 1981, for women, at special greens fees.
2. Entry fees for this tournament would be \$75 for men and \$50 for women. The City share of these fees would be \$24 of the men's fee and \$15 of the women's.
3. The exposure resulting from this tournament would be beneficial to the City's public golf program which would be in the best interests of the public, and therefore such use has been approved by the Commissioner in charge of the Bureau of Parks.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. Use of Rose City Golf Course is authorized for the Rose City Best Ball golf tournament on April 25 and 26, 1981, for men, and May 7 and 8, 1981, for women, at special greens fees as follows, notwithstanding provisions of Section 20.20.010 of the City Code:

The entry fee for men shall be \$75, with \$24 of this sum going to the City. The entry fee for women shall be \$50 with \$15 of this sum going to the City.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because delay in enactment of this ordinance would cause unnecessary difficulty in making arrangements for the tournament; therefore, this ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
