ORDINANCE NO. 151383

An Ordinance granting a revocable permit to the Portland Rose Festival Association to use propane cooking units in the festival center area between SW Front Avenue and the seawall from May 31 through June 15, 1981, notwithstanding the provisions of Title 31 of Ordinance No. 130672, Code of the City of Portland, Oregon, waiving permit fees, subject to certain conditions, and declaring an emergency.

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. That the Portland Rose Festival Association, by Clayton W. Hannon, Executive Manager, for and on behalf of Rainier Shows, Ed Roske Concessionaires, and other concessionaires, has requested the use of propane cooking units in the festival area from May 31 through June 15, 1981.
2. That this will permit the sale of hot foods during the festival and that it would be in the public interest to permit such units during this period of festivity; and,
3. That the permit fee should be waived and the permit granted.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. That a revocable permit hereby be granted to the Portland Rose Festival Association to use propane cooking units in the festival center area, notwithstanding the provisions of Title 31 of Ordinance No. 130672, Code of the City of Portland, Oregon, during the period from May 31 through June 15, 1981, and that the permit fee be waived, subject to the following terms and conditions:
 - (1) Each unit is limited to two 25-gallon (100 lbs.) propane cylinders manifolded in service and two on standby as extra fuel.
 - (2) All cylinders shall be fastened down to the ground by chains to substantial steel pipes or stakes, or otherwise substantially supported by chains in an upright position as approved by the Fire Marshal.
 - (3) No liquid transfer is to be allowed unless it is authorized by the Fire Marshal's Office.
 - (4) All tanks, hoses and burners will be inspected and approved by the Fire Marshal prior to operation.

- (5) The use of the propane cooking units shall be limited to the festival area, and subject to the provisions contained in Title 8 of Ordinance No. 130672, Code of the City of Portland, with reference to health and sanitation.
- (6) This permit shall not become effective until the permittee shall have filed with the City Auditor, in form approved by the City Attorney, an insurance policy in case of injury to one person, \$300,000 or more for personal injury arising from any one accident, and \$300,000 or more for property damage, said insurance to be for the protection of any persons sustaining personal injury or property damage due to the issuance of this permit; provided that if the grantee already has a policy meeting the provisions as to amount, a certificate of insurance or certified copy of said policy may be furnished provided that said policy is endorsed to include the City of Portland, the City Engineer, the officers, agents and employees of the City, as additional insureds.
- (7) This permit is revocable at any time in the event the public's need requires it and no expenditure of money hereunder, lapse of time, or other act or thing shall operate as an estoppel against the City of Portland, or be held to give the permittee any vested or other rights.


Section 2: This Ordinance will not become effective until the permittee has filed with the City Auditor a document, which has been approved by the City Attorney, accepting the terms and conditions hereof. This Ordinance shall be automatically revoked without further consideration by the Council if the terms and conditions are not accepted within sixty (60) calendar days of the passage of this Ordinance.

Section 3. The Council declares that an emergency exists because delay in the enactment of this Ordinance will result in an unnecessary hardship of uncertainty on the part of the applicant as to the status of the requested permit for the use of propane cooking units in the Rose Festival area; therefore, this Ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
