1. To Exhibit 'A', "Performance Modifications," add the following:

10. CAD FUNCTION: UTAM Terminal Management

ANALYSIS: No spare ports for terminals or printers exist, and we are aware of a current need for three additional such devices.

PROPOSED: Level Two recommends that additional ports be made available through the addition of required 64 port DCM's to the hardware, with necessary software corrections to recognize the additional ports.

EXPECTED BENEFITS:

This will both allow for current needs and future terminal additions when necessary and/or desireable.

PREREQUISITE: 2 - 64 port DCM's, 1 64 port A-B switch

11. MDT FUNCTION: New Program

ANALYSIS: BES has expressed a need to be able to study maintenance histories and failure patterns of equipment in their inventory or for which they have maintenance responsibility.

PROPOSED: Level Two recommends that a low priority foreground program be written to accomplish this task on the MDT system.

EXPECTED BENEFITS:

This modest program would utilize spare capacity in this system without detriment to the Mobil Digital Terminal Users and should improve the ability of BES to both diagnose equipment failure when it occurs and initiate preventive maintenance actions calculated to reduce instances of failure.
