ORDINANCE No. 151401

An Ordinance authorizing an amendment to Contract No. 19341 with Special Mobility Services, Inc., under the Human Resources Bureau, AU 682, Training and Employment Division by decreasing the contract in the amount of \$35,388; decreasing by five (5) the authorization of CETA Title IID positions and declaring an emergency.

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. Pursuant to Ordinance No. 151121, approved February 18, 1981, Council authorized Contract No. 19341 with Special Mobility Services, Inc., to train older workers in the field of job development, job placement, recruitment and referral services for the period February 23, 1981 through September 30, 1981.
- 2. Pursuant to March 2, 1981, notification was received from the Department of Labor, Region X that CETA Title IID positions, effective that date, were considered frozen.
- 3. Due to the Department of Labor's imposed freeze and subsequent reductions in the IID allocation, it is necessary to reduce the contract amount from \$173,379 to \$137,991.
- 5. It is therefore appropriate that the Commissioner-in-Charge and the City Auditor execute, on behalf of the City, amendments to Contract No. 19341 with Special Mobility Services, Inc., as set forth in Exhibit "A".

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

a. The Commissioner-in-Charge and the City Auditor are hereby authorized to execute, on behalf of the City, amendments to Contract No. 19341 with Special Mobility Services, Inc., as set forth in Exhibit "A".

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because delay in the enactment of this Ordinance will cause unnecessary problems in the administration of the CETA program; therefore, this Ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
