The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. The cash balance in the Civic Emergency Fund (Boxing Fund) on March 31, 1981 (for calendar year 1980) was \$13,561.99.
- 2. Under the provisions of ORS 463.170, 60% is payable to veterans' organizations entitled thereto, and 40% is payable to the Civic Emergency Trust Fund, and the said amounts should now be distributed.
