

ORDINANCE NO. 151407

An Ordinance authorizing annual distribution of Boxing Commission net proceeds, directing the Mayor and the Auditor to draw warrants totaling \$8,137.19 in favor of certain veterans' organizations entitled thereto, and a further warrant in the sum of \$5,424.80 in favor of the City Treasurer to be deposited in the Civic Emergency Trust Fund, and declaring an emergency.

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. The cash balance in the Civic Emergency Fund (Boxing Fund) on March 31, 1981 (for calendar year 1980) was \$13,561.99.
2. Under the provisions of ORS 463.170, 60% is payable to veterans' organizations entitled thereto, and 40% is payable to the Civic Emergency Trust Fund, and the said amounts should now be distributed.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Mayor and Auditor to draw and deliver warrants in favor of veterans' organizations listed below and in the amounts specified:

- b. The Mayor and Auditor to draw and deliver a warrant for \$5,424.80 in favor of the City Treasurer, the proceeds of which are to be deposited in the Civic Emergency Trust Fund (BUC 45089525). Said warrants shall be charged to the Civic Emergency Fund (493:000).

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because the annual distribution of the Boxing Commission net proceeds are now due and payable to certain veterans' organizations entitled thereto; therefore, this Ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
