Police respectfully report that owing to various complaints from the Garbage Master in regard to Scavengers delivering their Garbage &c., contrary to the provisions of Ordinance No. 6440, entitled, "An Ordinance to regulate the Pelivery of Garbage and waste matter to Scavengers" they visited the Crematory and found that the provisions of Section 3 of said Ordinance No. 6440 were totally disregarded and your Committee recommend that printed copies of said Ordinance be furnished the Health Officer for distribution to the Scavengers and that the provisions of said Ordinance be enforced and that printed signs be put up at the Grematory calling attention to the manner of hauling garbage as provided by said ordinance.
