### **Purpose of proposed legislation and background information:**

- The Bureau of Transportation section within Title 3 Administration is outdated and requires updates to ensure the most recent Portland Bureau of Transportation (PBOT) policies are reflected in the code language. Several sections have been added to ensure that the bureau's purpose, vision and mission, duties, and administrative rules and procedures are clearly stated.
- PBOT has published documents such as *PBOT's Strategic Plan: 2019-2022* that provide direction for the bureau. This code change ensures that these plans and goals are codified in Title 3.

### **Financial and budgetary impacts:**

- The ordinance only seeks to clarify existing code language and does not change any financial policies. Therefore, it will not have any budgetary impacts.
