ORDINANCE 151608

An Ordinance granting a park use permit to Portland Inter-Tribal Club to use the area from the restrooms west at East Delta Park for the Rose Festival Inter-Tribal Pow-Wow and Encampment from June 8, 1981 to June 19, 1981, under certain conditions, and declaring an emergency.

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. Portland Inter-Tribal Club by Terry Fast Horse, 3003 S.E. Belmont St., Portland, Oregon 97214, desires to use the area from the restrooms west at East Delta Park for the Rose Festival Inter-Tribal Pow-Wow and Encampment from June 8, 1981 to June 19, 1981.
- 2. The application has been approved by the Superintendent of Parks and the Commissioner-in-Charge of the Bureau of Parks.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- 1. A park use permit hereby is granted to Portland Inter-Tribal Club to use the area from the restrooms west at East Delta Park for the Rose Festival Inter-Tribal Pow-Wow and Encampment from June 8, 1981 to June 19, 1981, under the following conditions:
 - a. The permit hereby granted shall be revocable at the pleasure of the Commissioner-in-Charge and no expenditure of money hereunder or lapse of time or any act or thing shall operate as an estoppel against the City of Portland, or be held to give the permittee any vested or other right.
 - b. The permit hereby granted is personal to the permittee and may not be sold, assigned, or otherwise transferred by permittee or operation of law.
 - c. No area of the park may be used for spectator viewing, operation of concessions or parking of automobiles without specific approval of that use by the Superintendent of Parks.
 - d. Permittee hereby agrees at its own expense to clean up all debris resulting from use of the park area, and return all park areas within and contiguous to the permit area which have been occasioned by event participants to their original condition.

- e. Permittee agrees to provide at its own expense necessary security personnel to assure an orderly event.
- f. Permittee shall comply with all Park Bureau rules and regulations, all ordinances of the City of Portland, and all State laws.
- g. Permittee shall hold the City of Portland, its officers, agents and employees free and harmless from any claims for damages to persons or property, including legal fees and costs of defending any actions or suits, including any appeals which may result from the use of the park and roadway facilities under this permit and shall provide evidence of public liability insurance for bodily injury and property damage in the sum of \$300,000, naming the City, its officers and employees as additional insureds.
- h. Permittee shall agree to reimburse the City of Portland for any additional repair and cleanup costs beyond normal service to the park and contiguous areas occasioned by event participants, and shall furnish to the Bureau of Parks a bond or cash deposit in the amount of no less than \$5,000.
- The permit provided by this ordinance shall not become effective until permittee shall have filed with the City Auditor an acceptance of the terms and conditions of this Ordinance.
- Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because delay in enactment of this Ordinance would create an undue hinderance to complete arrangements for this event; therefore, this Ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
