ORDINANCE No. 151612

An Ordinance extending a contract with Metropolitan Family Service retroactively from March 1, 1981 to April 30, 1981 and declaring an emergency.

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. The City of Portland entered into a contract with Metropolitan Family Service for counseling services relative to the City/County Family Violence Project, Contract #18457.
2. Contract #18457 was originally intended to expire at the end of the grant period, or February 28, 1981.
3. On September 15, 1980 the granting agency, the Law Enforcement Assistance Administration, approved a request to extend the grant period to April 30, 1981 to increase the opportunity for the provision of counseling services. Due to administrative oversight the contract, #18457, was not extended at that time.
4. Costs of services provided under the contract have not exceeded the contract limits nor does this request for extension exceed that limit.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:


- a. Contract #18457 between the City of Portland and Metropolitan Family Service is hereby extended retroactively from March 1, 1981 to April 30, 1981.
- b. This Ordinance shall not become effective prior to receipt of acceptance by Metropolitan Family Service.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because all disbursements must be made during the close out period of LEAA grant #79-DF-AX-0114; therefore, this Ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
