ORDINANCE No. 151626

An Ordinance authorizing the Purchasing Agent to call for bids to furnish all materials, equipment, and labor for the construction of 133 curb ramps for the Bureau of Street and Structural Engineering, authorizing a contract, authorizing the drawing and delivery of warrants, and declaring an emergency.

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. That funds have been approved in the Bureau of Street and Structural Engineering's budget for FY 1980-81 to undertake the construction of 133 curb ramps in the downtown area and in several neighborhoods.
- 2. That the Bureau of Street and Structural Engineering requires the furnishing of all materials, equipment, and labor for the construction of these curb ramps in accordance with the plans and specifications filed with the Purchasing Division.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Purchasing Agent shall advertise for bids using plans and specifications filed in his office.
- b. A contract is authorized with the most favorable bidder.
- c. The Mayor and the Auditor are hereby authorized to draw and deliver warrants when demand is presented and approved by the proper authority.
- Section 2. The Council delares that an emergency exists in order for the contract to be let within the 1981-81 fiscal year, and because a delay may result in increased costs due to inflation; therefore this ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
