ORDINANCE NO. 151629

An Ordinance accepting a sewer easement required for the S.W. Dolph Court to its West Terminus and S.W. 23rd Avenue to its North Terminus Street Improvement Project, granted by St. Nicholas Orthodox Church of Portland, Oregon, authorizing payment of \$50.00, and declaring an emergency.

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- A sewer easement is required for construction of a storm sewer in connection with the S.W. Dolph Court to its Terminus and S.W. 23rd Avenue to its Terminus Street Improvement Project.
- 2. St. Nicholas Orthodox Church of Portland, Oregon has conveyed the required right of way to the City for the sum of \$50.00.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

a. That the following described easement is hereby accepted for sewer purposes:

A tract of land in Lot A, Block 1, Benirwin Addition, Multnomah County, Oregon, being a strip of land 10 feet in width, 5.0 feet on each side of the following described centerline.

Beginning at a point in the south line of S.W. Dolph Court as presently established 50 feet in width, said point being 43.55 feet east of the west line of said lot; thence south at right angles to said south street line 20.0 feet and there terminating.

- b. The Mayor and Auditor to draw and deliver a warrant in the amount of \$50.00 and in favor of St. Nicholas Orthodox Church of Portland, Oregon, said warrant to be charged to the General Fund (43300016/490) Appropriations, Contributions and Advances to Improvement Districts, and further directs the Mayor and Auditor to draw and deliver a warrant in the amount of \$50.00 to be credited to General Fund Revenue, said warrant to be drawn against and chargeable to the S.W. Dolph Court to its Terminus and S.W. 23rd Avenue to its North Terminus Street Improvement Project Fund when created.
- c. The Auditor shall record in the appropriate deed records, documents of title as necessary for purchase of this right of way.

ORDINANCE No.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because a delay in the acceptance of the sewer easement might jeopardize the City's ability to purchase the property at an appropriate price; therefore, this Ordinance shall be im force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
