ORDINANCE No. 151649

An Ordinance authorizing acceptance of Grant No. 81-14, Amendment #1, in the amount of \$558,976 from the State Office of Elderly Affairs to continue congregate nutrition services for the elderly of Portland/Multnomah County under Title III-C-1, Older Americans Act, of 1965, as amended, Human Resources Bureau, AU 380, Area Agency on Aging, for the period July 1, 1980, through June 30, 1981; amending the Fiscal Year 1980-81 City Budget by increasing appropriations by \$45,000, transferring funds, and declaring an emergency.

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. Pursuant to Ordinance No. 150070, approved July 23, 1980, City Council accepted Grant No. 81-14 in the sum of \$513,976 to continue congregate nutrition services for the elderly of Portland/Multnomah County for the period July 1, 1980, through June 30, 1981.
2. The Office of Elderly Affairs has awarded \$45,000 in carryover funds from Fiscal Year 1979-80, in accordance with the Fiscal Year 1980-81 Annual Plan.
3. Match is required in the amount of \$60,602 and will be provided by the nutrition contractors and City/County General Funds budgeted for Fiscal Year 1980-81.
4. It is, therefore, appropriate for the Mayor to accept, on behalf of the City, Grant No. 81-14, Amendment #1, in the amount of \$558,976 from the State Office of Elderly Affairs to continue congregate nutrition services for the elderly of Portland/Multnomah County under Title III-C-1, Older Americans Act of 1965, as amended, Human Resources Bureau, AU 380, Area Agency on Aging, for the period July 1, 1980, through June 30, 1981, as set forth in Exhibit "A," and to amend the Fiscal Year 1980-81 City Budget by increasing appropriations by \$45,000 and transferring funds.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Mayor is, hereby, authorized to accept on behalf of the City, Grant No. 81-41 Amendment #1, in the amount of \$558,976 from the State Office of Elderly Affairs to continue congregate nutrition services for the elderly of Portland/Multnomah County, under Title III-C-1, Older Americans Act of 1965, as amended, Human Resources Bureau, AU 380, Area Agency on Aging, for the period July 1, 1980,


