An Ordinance authorizing acceptance of Grant No. 81-14, Amendment #1, in the amount of \$558,976 from the State Office of Elderly Affairs to continue congregate nutrition services for the elderly of Portland/Multnomah County under Title III-C-1, Older Americans Act, of 1965, as amended, Human Resources Bureau, AU 380, Area Agency on Aging, for the period July 1, 1980, through June 30, 1981; amending the Fiscal Year 1980-81 City Budget by increasing appropriations by \$45,000, transferring funds, and declaring an emergency.

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- Pursuant to Ordinance No. 150070, approved July 23, 1980, City Council accepted Grant No. 81-14 in the sum of \$513,976 to continue congregate nutrition services for the elderly of Portland/Multnomah County for the period July 1, 1980, through June 30, 1981.
