ORDINANCE NO. 151651

An Ordinance transferring \$5,000 within the General Fund from Unforeseen Reimbursable Expenditures to the Bureau of Planning in support of the IPA Environmental Coordinator; transferring appropriations in the amount of \$2,000 within the Bureau of Sanitary Engineering; and declaring an emergency.

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. By Ordinance No. 150973, the Council authorized an agreement with the United States Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) under the Intergovernmental Personnel Act (IPA) to share the costs of an Environmental Coordinator for a one-year period. The total cost for the City's share may not exceed \$25,000.
- 2. Ordinance No. 150610 authorized a contract (No. 19099) with Metro, in the amount of \$60,000, to conduct a study on enhancing existing neighborhood commercial districts and appropriated \$35,000 for FY 1980-81.
- 3. The budget for the contract included \$5,000 for the IPA Environmental Coordinator which was not appropriated. These funds are now required and should be appropriated to the Bureau of Planning's FY 1980-81 budget.
- 4. The Bureau of Sanitary Engineering's FY 1980-81 budget includes \$2,000 for the IPA Environmental Coordinator. These funds should be transferred from Other Services-Internal to Professional Services.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

a. Appropriations are hereby transferred within the General Fund as follows:

The Council declares that an emergency exists because the appropriations are needed immediately so that there will be no delay or uncertainty in the execution of the work program of the IPA Environmental Coordinator; therefore, this Ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
