ORDINANCE No. 151663

An Ordinance waiving Section 33.98.040 of the Code to permit late acceptance of Variance No. VZ 374-79 and declaring an emergency.

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- The Variance Committee, on August 12, 1980, acting on the application of Vinko Bosnar and Slavko Blancic, deedholders, granted Variance No. VZ 374-79 to allow re-establishment of a non-conforming use for a commercial structure which has been vacant for three years on the south ½ of Lot 10, Block 18, City View Park located at 701 S.E. Miller Street. Pursuant to the Code, written acceptance of the variance was required by September 28, 1980. Acceptance was received from Slavko Blancic on September 5, 1980 but no acceptance was received from Vinko Bosnar. A contract purchase of the property by Gary T. and Marianne S. Nelson was contingent on approval of the variance.
- 2. The new owners, Gary T. and Marianne S. Nelson have requested the provision for acceptance by the former owner within 30 days be waived and that a signed acceptance by the new owners filed with the Auditor on May 26, 1981, together with the recording fee, be accepted and the variance to be in full force and effect.
- 3. The Bureau of Planning has recommended approval of the request and waiver of the Code.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. That Section 33.98.040 of the Code be waived in order to render late acceptance of Variance No. VZ 374-79 to be valid and the variance to be in full force and effect.
- Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because the variance described in Section 1 above should be effective immediately in order to avoid unnecessary delay and additional costs for the new deedholders; therefore, this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
