AGREEMENT AMENDING COUTRACT No. 18905

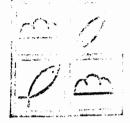
This agreement is entered into between the City of Portland and Loaves and Fishes Centers, Inc. The parties have previously executed a contract providing for the delivery of nutrition services to the elderly of Portland/Multnomah County for the period July 1, 1980, to June 30, 1981.

The parties, therefore, agree that Contract No. 18905 is amended as follows:

- 1. Revise congregate service level from 170,409 to 188,438 meals.
- 2. Revise home-delivered service level from 229,151 to 269,167 meals.
- 3. Funds in the amount of \$12,000 under Title III-C-1 are provided for the completion of renovation to the meal site at the Northwest Service Center.
- 4. Increase United States Department of Agriculture meal reimbursement, through the City, from \$137,630 to \$165,058.
- 5. Increase congregate meal program income from \$95,176 to \$110,305.
- 6. Increase home-delivered meals program income from \$148,798 to \$189,433.

These changes are incorporated in Contract No. 18905 as set forth in the attached pages.

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Richard C. Mastbrook Executive Director Amendment to Contract #18905 between City of Portland and Loaves & Fishes Centers, Inc.

Attached hereto are revised budget pages for Contract #18905. We have completed an analysis of actual costs incurred during the first seven months of the contract and have revised the unit costs based on our revised projections. We were able to lower our cost projections on raw food, vehicle operating costs and utilities which, when combined with other less major line item adjustments, resulted in a revision of the Congregate meal cost from \$3.235 to \$3.148/meal. The mileage cost projection was also reduced which combined with the above outlined adjustments resulted in a lowering of the Home Delivered meal cost from \$3.022 to \$2.892/meal. In addition we added a total of 18,029 congregate meals and 40,016 home delivered meals to the contract. (It should be noted here that this increase in meals was included in our original estimate of meals provided to the OEA office last spring, and should, therefore, not cause any difficulty in USDA reimbursement.)

We have also included a \$12,000 request of Title III C-1 funds for continuation of the meal site renovation at NWSC.

Following is a summary of the budgetary changes being requested:

- 1. Congregate meals from 170,409 to 188,438 (+18,029).
- 2. Home Delivered meals from 229,151 to 269,167 (+40,016).
- 3. U.S.D.A. Income for period 10-01-80 to 06-30-81 decreased from \$137,630 to -0-, to remove from City Support (-\$137,630).

- NWSC Meal Site Renovation from -0- to \$12,000 (+\$12,000). 4.
- The two items above decrease total City Support from 5. \$829,430 to \$766,800 (-\$125,630).
- Congregate Program Income from \$95,176 to \$110,305 6. (+\$15,129).
- Home Delivered Program Income from \$148,798 to \$189,433 7. (+\$40,635).
- Congregate required match from \$37,740 to \$35,167 8. (-\$2,573).
- 9. Home Delivered required match from \$23,063 to \$41,513 (+\$18.450).
- Congregate USDA from \$18,501 to \$87,209 (+\$68,708). 10.
- 11. Home Delivered USDA from \$28,058 to \$124,408 (+\$96,350).
- 12. Congregate Other Resources from -0- to \$20,854 (+\$20,854).
- Home Delivered Other Resources from -0- to \$7,946 (+\$7,946). 13.
- 14. The total contract from \$1,243,766 to \$1,383,635 (+\$139,869).

This amendment request reflects total projected participant meals to be served during the contract period at our best projection of actual cost of delivery.

We ask that appropriate fiscal and contract monitoring staff meet with us at our office as soon as possible to review any questions you may have on how the unit costs and income projections in this amendment were compiled.

Program Income/Match funds are given by the participants and volunteers within the program and are largely dependent upon the Older Americans Act funds to supply the initial funding. These funds while they vary from time to time are a stable-ongoing source of funding. USDA funding is provided by the Federal Government through a cash-in-lieu of commodity food program. They are dependent upon continued funding by Congress.

ORDINANCE NO. 151671

An Ordinance authorizing an amendment to Contract No. 18905 with Loaves and Fishes Centers, Inc., Human Resources Bureau, AU 380, Area Agency on Aging, by increasing the contract amount in the sum of \$39,428 to a new total of \$931,858, for the period of July 1, 1980, to June 30, 1981, modifying service levels and declaring an emergency.

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. Pursuant to Ordinance No. 150174, approved by Council August 6, 1980, the City entered into a contract with Loaves and Fishes Centers, Inc. to provide nutrition services to the elderly of Portland/Multnomah County for the period of July 1, 1980, to June 30, 1981.
- 2. Pursuant to Ordinance No. 148612, approved by Council October 17, 1979, the City provided funds to establish a meal facility within the Northwest Service Center through Contract No. 18175 with Loaves and Fishes Centers, Inc. Funds have been accepted from Title III-C-1 of the Older Americans Act through the Office of Elderly Affairs, for the completion of renovation of this site in the amount of \$12,000, as shown in Exhibit "A".
- Pursuant to Ordinance No. 151206, approved by Council March 4, 1981, United States Department of Agriculture meal reimbursements are disbursed through the City for all meals served since October 1, 1980.
- Pursuant to a recent analysis conducted by Loaves and Fishes Centers, Inc., the cost per meal has been reduced, which will result in an increase in congregate and home-delivered meals from 399,560 to 457,605.
- 5. Pursuant to this adjustment, the United States Department of Agriculture reimbursement will be increased in the amount of \$27,428.
- 6. It is, therefore, appropriate that the Commissioner of Public Utilities and the Auditor execute, on behalf of the City, an amendment to Contract No. 18905 with Loaves and Fishes Centers, Inc., by increasing the contract amount in the sum of \$39,428 to a new total of \$931,858 for the period of July 1, 1980, through June 30, 1981, modifying service levels as set forth in Exhibit "A".

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

The Commissioner of Public Utilities and the City Auditor are hereby authorized to execute, on behalf of the City, an amendment to Contract No. 18905 with Loaves and Fishes Centers, Inc., by increasing the contract amount in the sum of \$39,428 to a new total of \$931,858 for the period of

July 1, 1980, through June 30, 1981, modifying service levels as set forth in Exhibit "A".

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because delay in the enactment of this Ordinance may result in an interruption of services to the elderly; therefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
