

## O R D I N A N C E   N O.   151673

An Ordinance authorizing the donation of certain surplus property to Portland Public Schools Motor Development team, not withstanding provisions of Section 5.36.010 of the Code of the City of Portland, and declaring an emergency.

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1.      The Council finds:

1.    The City's Property Warehouse currently has on hand ten (10) electric typewriters which have been turned in as surplus City property for disposal.
2.    The Motor Development team of the Portland Public Schools has requested by letter the donation of some of these machines to their program.
3.    The Purchasing department for the Portland Public Schools has examined these surplus typewriters and find two of them to be in acceptable condition.
4.    The revenue generated at auction sale for these two typewriters would probably not exceed \$150.
5.    Since the Motor Development team is a new program, with limited resources, and is designed to meet the requirements of federal law P.C. 94-142, the Handicapped Education Act, these items are appropriate for donation to this program.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a.    The Purchasing Agent is hereby authorized to donate two (2) electric typewriters from City surplus property to the Motor Development team of the Portland Public Schools, notwithstanding the provisions of Section 5.36.010 of the City Code.

ORDINANCE No. 151673

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists in order that there be no delay in providing authority for the donation mentioned in Section 1 hereof; therefore, this Ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
