ORDINANCE No. 151674

An Ordinance authorizing acceptance of Grant No. 81-132 in the sum of \$2,061 from the Oregon State Office of Elderly Affairs to provide community forums as part of the State White House Conference on Aging, Human Resources Bureau, AU 380, Area Agency on Aging, for the period October 1, 1980, through March 31, 1981, amending the Fiscal Year 1980-81 City Budget by increasing appropriations, transferring funds, and declaring an emergency.

The city of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. Pursuant to Ordinance No. 149809, approved June 25, 1980, City Council approved the Fiscal Year 1980-81 Annual Plan of Action for aging services which includes the provision for community forums to take place in Portland and Multnomah County as part of the State White House Conference on Aging planning activities.
- 2. Indirect costs are not allowed.
- 3. City match is not required.
- 4. It is, therefore, appropriate for the Mayor to accept, on behalf of the City, Grant No. 81-132 in the sum of \$2,061 from the Oregon State Office of Elderly Affairs to provide community forums as part of the State White House Conference on Aging, Human Resources Bureau, AU 380, Area Agency on Aging, for the period October 1, 1980, through March 31, 1981, as set forth in Exhibit "A," and to amend the Fiscal Year 1980-81 City Budget by increasing appropriations and transferring funds.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

a. The Mayor is hereby authorized to accept, on behalf of the City, Grant No. 81-132 in the sum of \$2,061 from the Oregon State Office of Elderly Affairs to provide community forums as part of the State White House Conference on Aging, Human Resources Bureau, AU 380, Area Agency on Aging, for the period October 1, 1980, through March 31, 1981, as set forth in Exhibit "A," and to amend the Fiscal Year 1980-81 City Budget by increasing appropriations and transferring funds.
