- *An immediate expansion of Behavioral Health Unit with a caveat that police be accompanied by mental health professionals when ever possible;
- *An immediate expansion in # of police with additional caveat that all new hires and/or rehiring of retired police receive mental health crisis training; and
- * Increase in funding to lower 911 response.

I especially commend Commissioner Mapps for offering measurable outcomes regarding reduction in homelessness and other important issues with specified time lines as follows:

- *Hiring of 300 police officers within 3 years;
