My name is Luke Norman and I am a resident of the Irvington neighborhood. I **strongly support the Shelter to Housing Continuum** project and urge you to pass it without delay.

Additionally, I encourage you to adopt amendments to allow more flexibility for placing sanctioned Outdoor Shelters equitably across our city proposed by Portland: Neighbors Welcome. In graduate school I had the privilege to work with local organizers who had experienced homelessness in their efforts to develop immediate housing options for the very poor. These organizers shared how cities, churches, and other community-based organizations could partner to provide sanctioned Outdoor Shelters, which create safe and empowering environments for residents. **S2HC** has the opportunity to foster these partnerships by allowing sanctioned Outdoor Shelters to be sited in Open Space zones, except for Parks and sensitive natural areas AND by allowing churches and community-based organizations to host sanctioned Outdoor Shelters by right in all zones.

Together these amendments will ensure that all neighborhoods have the opportunity to host sanctioned Outdoor Shelters and create safe and empowering environments that all Portlanders deserve.
