In cases of natural disaster or other emergency, camping makes sense, but it should not be allowed as a solution to the region's ongoing challenges with homelessness. In some cases, it may make sense to use parts of some large or unused parks for a proposal like this, but it makes little sense to allow this when there are other options available.
