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Ordinance No.

An ordinance accepting certain property for the widening of Sandy Boulevard, and declaring an emergency.

The City of Portland does ordain as follows:

Section 1. That the following described property be and is hereby accepted by the City of Portland for street purposes:

Beginning at a point on the south line of lot 4, block 199, East Portland 34.05 feet west of the southeast corner of said lot 4, measured along the south line thereof; thence west along said south line 12.81 feet to a point; thence northeasterly to a point on the east line of said lot 4, said point lying 46.86 feet north of the southeast corner of said lot 4, measured along said east line; thence southwesterly to the place of beginning.

Section 2. That the City Engineer be and he is hereby directed to have the deed to the property described in Section 1 of this ordinance placed on record.

Section 3. Inasmuch as this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, peace and safety of the City of Portland in this: It is necessary that this property be immediately opened to the public for the widening of Sandy Boulevard; therefore an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
