ORDINANCE No. 151845

An Ordinance repealing Section 16.36.100, Impounding Automobiles, of the Code of the City of Portland and declaring an emergency.

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. That, since the enactment of Chapter 16.04, Towing and Disposition of Vehicles, Section 16.36.100, Impounding Automobiles, is a confusing and conflicting section of the Code.
- 2. That Section 16.36.100 should be repealed.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. That Section 16.36.100, Impounding Automobiles, is hereby repealed.
- Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because delay will endanger the public health, welfare and safety of citizens of the City; therefore, this ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
