151845

An Ordinance repealing Section 16.36.100, Impounding Automobiles, of the Code of the City of Portland and declaring an emergency.

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. That, since the enactment of Chapter 16.04, Towing and Disposition of Vehicles, Section 16.36.100, Impounding Automobiles, is a confusing and conflicting section of the Code.
2. That Section 16.36.100 should be repealed.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:


- a. That Section 16.36.100, Impounding Automobiles, is hereby repealed.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because delay will endanger the public health, welfare and safety of citizens of the City; therefore, this ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
