

ORDINANCE No. 151899

An Ordinance revising the salary rates in the Compensation Plan for the position of Emergency Services Operator, and declaring an emergency.

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. That the Employee Relations Officer, at the request of the Bureau of Emergency Communications, has conducted a review of the salary rate for the position of Emergency Services Operator.
2. On the basis of that review, the Bureau of Personnel has recommended a new salary range for this classification.
3. The change should be made effective immediately.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

Hourly rates in the Compensation Plan for the following classification is revised effective upon passage of this ordinance:

0321	Emergency Services Operator	\$5.33	\$5.85	\$6.39	\$6.74

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists in order that there be no unnecessary delay in revising the salary rate as outlined in Section 1 hereof; therefore, this Ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
