

ORDINANCE No. 151903

An Ordinance establishing salary rates for the new position of Street Lighting Manager in the Street Lighting Division of the Bureau of Street and Structural Engineering, effective July 1, 1981.

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. A new classification of Street Lighting Manager was approved in 1981-82 budget of the Bureau of Street and Structural Engineering;
2. Since the program emphasis in Street Lighting Division will be shifting in anticipation of the end of the Street Lighting serial levy, the Civil Service Board has determined that new duties assigned to the Street Lighting Manager are more appropriately associated with an Engineer III salary range.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. Effective July 1, 1981, the Street Lighting Manager position in the Council approved budget for 1981-82 shall have the following salary range:
