

ORDINANCE No. 151960

An Ordinance amending Section 5.52.010 of the City Code to create a petty cash account in the amount of \$300 for the Bureau of Sanitary Engineering - Administration, authorizing a warrant for \$300 and declaring an emergency.

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. The Bureau of Sanitary Engineering has been using the Petty Cash account of the Bureau of Streets & Structures to reimburse employees for purchase of various miscellaneous supplies.
- 2. In order for the Bureau of Sanitary Engineering to assume its proper responsibility and establish accountability, a petty cash account in the amount of \$300 should be created for the Bureau of Sanitary Engineering - Administration.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. Section 5.52.010 of the City Code is amended to create a petty cash account for the Bureau Administration section as follows:

Sewage Fund

 Bureau of Sanitary Engineering
 Administrative Section \$300

- b. The Mayor and the Auditor hereby are directed to draw and deliver a warrant in the amount of \$300 to the Bureau of Sanitary Engineering: said warrant to be charged to the Sewage Fund Contingency (710) and appropriated to BUC 14820019, Object Code 490.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists in order that there may be no unnecessary delay in creating a petty cash account for the Bureau of Sanitary Engineering; therefore, this Ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
