

A G R E E M E N T

THIS CONTRACT entered into between Dr. Charles H. King, Urban Crisis Center, 1655 Peachtree Center, Suite 905, Atlanta, Georgia 30309, hereinafter referred to as "Consultant", and the City of Portland, a municipal corporation of Oregon, hereinafter referred to as the "CITY".

W I T N E S S E T H :

The parties hereto agree as follows:

1. Consultant hereby agrees to conduct four affirmative action workshops entitled "A Better Approach to Affirmative Action" on the following dates: September 28-29, 1981; September 30 and October 1, 1981; October 5-6, 1981; and October 7-8, 1981.
2. The City agrees to pay Consultant \$4,500 per workshop.
3. The City also agrees to provide transportation, meals, lodging and training site. These expenses are anticipated to be approximately \$3,600, but not to exceed \$4,000.

ORDINANCE No. 151964

An Ordinance authorizing the Commissioner of Public Works and the Auditor to execute a contract between the City of Portland and Dr. Charles H. King, Urban Crisis Center, to provide four Affirmative Action workshops for managers and supervisors, and declaring an emergency.

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. Dr. Charles H. King has conducted two workshops entitled "A Better Approach to Affirmative Action" for the Bureau of Personnel Services which were well received by managers and supervisors.
2. The Bureau of Personnel Services has consulted with other bureaus and by combining resources feel that they can meet their commitment to provide affirmative action training through further use of his services.
3. Dr. Charles H. King has agreed to conduct four workshops on September 28-29, 1981; September 30 and October 1, 1981; October 5-6, 1981; and October 7-8, 1981, at a cost of \$4,500 per workshop plus expenses anticipated to be in the neighborhood of \$3,600, but not to exceed \$4,000.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. That the Commissioner of Public Works and Auditor are hereby authorized to execute a contract between the City and Dr. Charles H. King for four affirmative action workshops.
- b. The Contract shall be charged to the General Fund, Bureau of Personnel Services, Education, 410.
- c. Said agreement to conform to the form of agreement attached to the original only of this Ordinance marked Exhibit "A" which, by this reference, is made a part hereof.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because confirmation of this agreement is needed in order that Dr. King may reserve this time on his calendar, therefore, this Ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
