Legislation title: Authorize signatory authority to the Director of the Office for Community Technology for letter agreements granting access to the public right-of-way (Ordinance)

Purpose of proposed legislation and background information:

The ordinance authorizes the Director of the Office for Community Technology (OCT) to sign letter agreements granting utility operators access to the public right-of-way until the new code standardizing terms for access to the right-of-way is effective, which is anticipated to be January 1, 2023. The signatory authority will allow OCT to grant access to the right-of-way to utility operators without existing franchises. Staff anticipate the Director will sign approximately four letter agreements until the new code is effective.
