### **Collin's View Tank, 118 SW Alice St. (R137886) – 1 Comment**

Portland Water Bureau (PWB) received an email from one (1) member of the St. John's Neighborhood Association who would like to see it developed as a park. This commenter was offered other ideas. The commenter was worried about other types of development that may occur on this site.

### **Fulton Pump Station, 540 S Nevada St. (R330285) – 2 Comments**

- PWB received two (2) emails from two (2) separate individuals stating that they believed that when the PWB sells the location, the money should go to the City of Portland Parks and Recreation (Parks). PWB worked with Parks to circulate the information and confirm that no funds will be distributed to Parks from the Sale. PWB followed by sending the Fulton Pump Station Ordinance and the Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) documents between PWB and Parks to the appropriate parties for reference.
