RECITALS:

WHEREAS, Oregon Walks and the City are Parties to “City Contract #32002279 Subrecipient Agreement, Project: Portland Bureau of Transportation- Smart Trips, Connected Communities” signed 2020.08.25 (The “Agreement”); Authorized on July 20, 2020, by Ordinance No. 190055; and

WHEREAS, On October 27, 2021, Metro, the grant administrator formally notified project managers that the three-year grant will be extended for an additional fourth year due to the pandemic. The additional year allows for continued work on existing transportation demand management projects and/or changes to programming in response to the pandemic; and

WHEREAS, the Parties wish to amend the Agreement to set forth a new expiration date for completion of the parties’ obligations and responsibilities in connection with providing Smart Trips, Connected Communities programming.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Parties hereby agree as follows:

I. The Agreement is amended to:

- a. Update the expiration date of 6/30/2021 to 6/30/2023 in “Section B: Effective Date and Duration”
- b. Update performance report schedule in Exhibit A to include an additional four quarters as outlined below.
