Purpose of proposed legislation and background information:

- PBOT seeks to extend the date of our contracts with four community organizations performing work as subrecipients of the Regional Transportation Options Grant.
- The contracts will be updated from having a completion date of June 31, 2021 to a new date of June 31, 2023. This extension allows for the original scope, delayed due to the pandemic, to be completed by a new deadline.

Financial and budgetary impacts:

- The four subrecipients named above were awarded \$102,000.00 for a three-year period. The award amount does not change with this amendment, but the timeline does.
